
COOKIE POLICY

This Cookie Policy (the “*Cookie Policy*”) sets out how Luminora Solutions Corp. (the “*Company*”, “*Luminora*”, “*we*”, or “*us*”) relies on cookies and similar technologies in operating its website (the “*Website*”) and providing its services (the “*Services*”). Continuing to use the Website constitutes your acknowledgement of this Cookie Policy and, where applicable law permits, your acceptance of the use of cookies and similar technologies as described herein. The Company may revise this Cookie Policy at any time by publishing the updated version and amending the “Last Updated Date” shown above.

1. COOKIE INVENTORY

1.1. The categories and purposes of the cookies we use are set out in **Section 2** of this Cookie Policy. Where the Company uses a consent management platform, more detailed cookie information may also be available through the preference centre accessible on the Website.

2. CATEGORIES OF COOKIES WE USE

- 2.1.** The Company and its third-party service providers use cookies and similar technologies for a variety of operational, security, analytical, functional, and advertising purposes.
- 2.2.** Certain cookies are required for the operation, security, and integrity of the Website. These technologies enable core functionality, support the management of user preferences, facilitate form submissions, help prevent fraudulent activity, and ensure the proper delivery of the Services. Disabling such technologies may result in some parts of the Website becoming unavailable or functioning improperly.
- 2.3.** The Company may use cookies and similar technologies to remember information about your preferences and interactions with the Website in order to improve usability, personalise certain features, and enhance your overall experience. Information collected for these purposes may be aggregated or anonymised where appropriate.
- 2.4.** Cookies and similar technologies may also be used to collect statistical and analytical information regarding the performance and use of the Website, including information relating to traffic patterns, user interactions, system performance, and technical issues. Such information is generally used to maintain, develop, and improve the Website and the Services.
- 2.5.** The Company and authorised third-party providers may use cookies and similar technologies to better understand user engagement across the Website and other digital platforms and, where applicable, to support analytics, operational performance, and the improvement of the Website and the Services. Authorised third-party providers may also use cookies and similar technologies to measure the effectiveness of advertising activities and to provide content that may be relevant to users. Any such use is subject to applicable law, including any applicable consent requirements.

3. HOW WE USE COOKIES

3.1. The Company uses cookies and similar technologies to:

- (i) enable the Website to function properly;
 - (ii) remember your settings or preferences where applicable;
 - (iii) understand how visitors use the Website;
 - (iv) support security, fraud prevention, and abuse detection;
 - (v) support analytics and operational performance; and
 - (vi) improve the Website, the Services, and the user experience.

4. HOW LONG COOKIES REMAIN ON YOUR DEVICE

- 4.1. The duration for which cookies remain stored on your device varies depending on their function and configuration. Some cookies operate only for the duration of your browsing session and are automatically removed when your browser is closed, while others remain on your device for a longer predefined period before expiring automatically, which may range from a few days to several weeks or months.

5. THIRD-PARTY SERVICES

- 5.1. The Company may use third-party providers for analytics, hosting, infrastructure, security, and other operational functions. Those providers may set or access cookies or similar technologies when you interact with the Website. The Company does not control third-party cookies and recommends that you review the relevant third party's own privacy and cookie policies for further information. Where the Company engages such providers, it seeks to ensure through appropriate contractual or organisational arrangements that they apply privacy and security measures that are not less protective than those maintained by the Company, to the extent appropriate and reasonably practicable.

6. MANAGING AND DISABLING COOKIES

- 6.1. When you use the Website or the Services, you expressly accept that the Company may store cookies on your device in the manner set out in this Cookie Policy. That said, your browser will usually let you review the cookies held on your device, decline some or all of them, erase those already stored, or be alerted when new ones are placed; consult your browser's settings for details on how to adjust, block, or filter cookies.
- 6.2. Deleting all cookies will also clear any choices you have previously recorded, including any choice to opt out of cookies, because that opt-out is itself stored as a cookie. Where you turn off or block particular cookies, certain parts of the Website or the Services may stop working correctly, become inaccessible, or deliver a reduced experience.

7. RELATIONSHIP WITH THE PRIVACY POLICY

- 7.1. Data gathered by means of cookies and similar technologies may amount to Personal Information for the purposes of applicable law.
